VOLUNTEER ROLE DESCRIPTIONS Adult Altar Server Assisting with Church services. Overseeing junior altar servers. **Adult Support Worker** Voluntary worker in groups or clubs for vulnerable adults. **Asylum Seeker Worker** Volunteer providing immediate assistance or access to support agencies for those seeking asylum status. Offering home and social support to those suffering loss. **Bereavement Support** Caretaker/ Volunteer Responsible for any building or grounds used by children, young **Maintenance Worker** people or vulnerable adults, where contact may occur. **Children's Liturgy Worker** Looking after children involved in their own Church worship group. **Church Care Organisation** Offering various pastoral, social support and care services both in Volunteer Church and in the home - e.g. St. Vincent de Paul Society, Legion of Mary, Mercy Associates etc. **Eucharistic Minister** Distributing Communion to individuals, either in Church or in the home. This position of trust allows privileged access to children, young people and particularly vulnerable adults. **Healing Ministry Group** Offering care and prayerful support to vulnerable individuals or Worker groups. Home or hospital visitor Calling on vulnerable individuals to offer a range of pastoral support Keyholder/ Cleaner Having sole access to buildings where children, young people or vulnerable adults may meet. Leader on Youth Adult responsible for young pilgrims assisting on either residential or **Pilgrimages** day pilgrimages. Leading, or having designated responsibility for children or young **Music Ministry/ Drama Groups** people in music, choral or drama groups of mixed age ranges. Parent & Toddler Group Overseeing individual or groups of children. Organiser/ Crèche Worker Parish Secretary/ Having front-line contact with the public, access to confidential Administrator information and exercising organisational roles with individuals and groups. Parish Welfare Officer Volunteer responsible for health and safety issues within parish buildings or grounds, where contact may occur. Pastoral Assistant/ Exercising a key role with the Parish Priest to provide a range of **Minister** administrative and pastoral supports for the people of the parish/ Pilgrimage Volunteer Adult with roles of responsibility and access to vulnerable adults on pilgrimages Presbytery/ Parish Having front-line contact with members of the public visiting the Housekeeper presbytery/ parish house with a range of pastoral needs. Resident in Presbytery/ Having front-line contact with members of the public visiting the Chaplaincy presbytery/ chaplaincy with a range of pastoral needs. **Sacramental Programme** Assisting/ instructing children, young people or vulnerable adults in **Worker/ Catechist** the development of their faith. Sacristan The practical requirements of preparation for Church services involve contact with young altar servers. Social Organiser/ Helper Those organising or facilitating recreational/ fundraising activities in the name of the Church. Transport Volunteer Driving or assisting children, young people or vulnerable adults to and from religious or social events. Watching Group Individuals present in Church or chaplaincy offering 'open house' facility for those seeking quiet, prayerful refuge, where contact with the young and vulnerable may occur. Welcomer Individuals who meet those entering Church/ hall for services or functions and facilitate physical assistance where required. **Youth Group Volunteer** Worker in clubs for children and/ or young people run by an organisation operating in the name of the Church.
