## Governor News – January 2021

This is a monthly summary to help governors keep up to date with key themes of national education policy, the local Diocesan context, research and good practice.

I am pleased to confirm that we have increased the number of Gift-ED licences to 10 per school, so if you would like to nominate further governors to access the library of Diocesan courses <u>please let us know by using this link</u>

<u>Teachers' estimated grades will replace cancelled A-levels and GCSEs this summer</u>. For primaries, there will be no Year 6 Sats tests this year. <u>DfE have also confirmed legally</u> <u>binding requirements for schools to provide high-quality remote education for three to five</u> <u>hours a day</u>, depending on a child's age, saying 'this is mandatory for all state-funded schools and will be enforced by Ofsted'

Is staff wellbeing a regular agenda item at your full governing body meeting? The Diocese of Brentwood has a <u>model policy on staff wellbeing</u> you can use or adapt.

The government have issued guidance on how schools should carry out pre-employment checks on teachers coming from the EU, Iceland, Liechtenstein and Norway (EEA) from 1 January 2021

Admission authorities must have determined their admission arrangements for entry in September 2022 by **28 February 2021**. Please make sure you follow the <u>CES model</u> <u>admissions arrangements</u> and the <u>CES model supplementary information form</u> when revising your School Admissions Policy. Ofsted have <u>published guidance and details of plans from January 2021 as part of a phased</u> <u>return to full inspection</u> From January 2021, they will resume monitoring inspections of schools judged as requires improvement or inadequate. They will also continue to carry out section 8 'no formal designation' (NFD) inspections if they have significant concerns about any school
