Feast day of St Simon Stock: 16th May



St Simon Stock was a 13th-century Englishman, a prior of the Carmelite order. It is said that the Blessed Virgin Mary appeared to him and gave him the Carmelite habit, including the Brown Scapular, the piece of cloth worn over the habit. He was a man of great holiness and devotion, who always in his prayers asked the Virgin to favour his Order with some singular privilege. The Virgin appeared to him holding the Scapular in her hand saying, "This is for you and yours a privilege; the one who dies in it will be saved."
