St Anthony was born into a rich family in Portugal but gave up wealth to be a poor Franciscan. He preached in Morocco and his skill led St Francis, the founder of the Order, to entrust the friars' studies to him. He taught at the universities of Montpellier and Toulouse. He died at the age of only 35, and is depicted as holding the Christ Child, referencing a vision he once had. We pray for St Anthony's intercession when we have lost things.
