Blessed Eugenia was born in the district of Milan called Crescenzaga in 1867. Her father was a famous travelling musician and she was often left with her grandparents; then her father disappeared and her home life became difficult. She ran away from home at the age of 20 and joined the Congregation of the Little Daughters of the Sacred Hearts of Jesus and Mary. She became their Superior General in 1911 and was a kind mother to all she met. She suffered ill health patiently, dying in 1921; she is remembered as a model of virtue and a wise teacher.
