

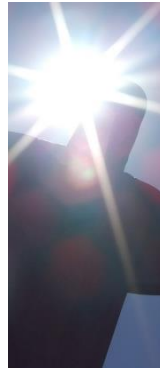

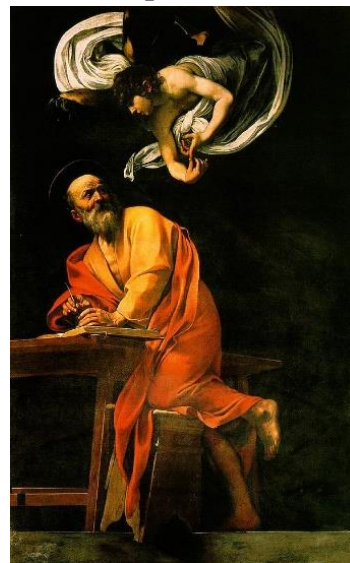

Saint Matthew
Feast day:
21st September



Matthew was a tax collector, as such he would have been despised by his fellow Jews as he worked for the Roman occupying forces. Matthew invited Jesus to dinner, causing the Pharisees and Scribes to criticise Jesus. Jesus' response recorded in the Gospel was that He had not come to call the righteous but to call sinners to repent.

St Matthew is remembered as one of the Four Evangelists.
