Feast of St Richard of Chichester : 16th June

St Richard was bishop of Chichester in West Sussex from 1244 until his death in 1253. He lived a simple life, refused to eat off silver platters and was a vegetarian since his student days at Oxford. His tomb became a shrine and place of pilgrimage and he was declared a saint only 9 years after he died. Sadly,



his shrine was destroyed on the orders of Thomas Cromwell during the Reformation. His alternate feast day of 16th June is celebrated as Sussex Day, as he is patron of the county.
