Governor News - October 2022

This is a monthly summary to help governors keep up to date with key themes of national education policy, the local Diocesan context, research and good practice.

Please note that <u>CES has updated its guidance for governing boards on the recruitment of staff.</u> As well as a more general update, the document reflects the new requirements in KCSIE (Sept 2022) to undertake online searches of shortlisted candidates. Compliance with this guidance is a requirement in the model diocesan protocols on staffing and recruitment

A reminder that participating in appropriate Catholic governor training is an expectation of all governors regardless of length of service and experience; we will be looking for evidence of this before approving the re-appointment of foundation governors. We have developed both <u>online courses</u> and <u>webinars</u> to support governors in our schools

Look out for the revised 2022 version of the Diocesan Protocols, which will be issued soon

How do you as governors promote, monitor and evaluate the provision for the Catholic life and mission of the school, RE and collective worship-prayer and liturgy? Schools in the Brentwood Diocese will start to be inspected under the new CSI Framework from January 2023 so don't miss the opportunity to attend our CSI webinar for governors on 28 November 2022 (17:30-19:00)

As previously advised, DfE has recently published <u>revised statutory guidance on permanent exclusions</u>. There are some important changes including more emphasis on taking a pupil's views into account and involving them in the process. The success of all governance is dependent on developing strong working relationships. Don't forget that schools must now have a uniform policy, which is published on the school website and publish details of where second-hand uniform can be purchased. There is an obligation on schools to ensure that required uniform items do not impact in an unfair way financially on some households. Is your school compliant?

This year's annual report explores children's experiences of school and the impact of the pandemic and cost of living on children and their families. DfE are <u>seeking the views of governors and</u> trustees on the current school food guidance
