The Liturgical Vision of Pope Benedict

Fr Joseph Ratzinger was chosen as a theological adviser at the Second Vatican Council and was an extremely influential voice. His subsequent career as Cardinal Archbishop of Munich and as Prefect of the Congregation of the Doctrine of the Faith in Rome led him to develop his theological and liturgical ideas. He became Pope in 2005, resigning in 2013. He was a great promoter of the beauty of Catholic Liturgy.

Fr D. Vincent Twomey SVD became a doctoral student of Professor Ratzinger in 1971. He met regularly with Pope Benedict until their last meeting in 2022. He has recently published *The Dynamics of Liturgy: Joseph Ratzinger's Theology of Liturgy: An Interpretation*. He is professor emeritus of Moral Theology at the Pontifical University of Maynooth in Ireland.
