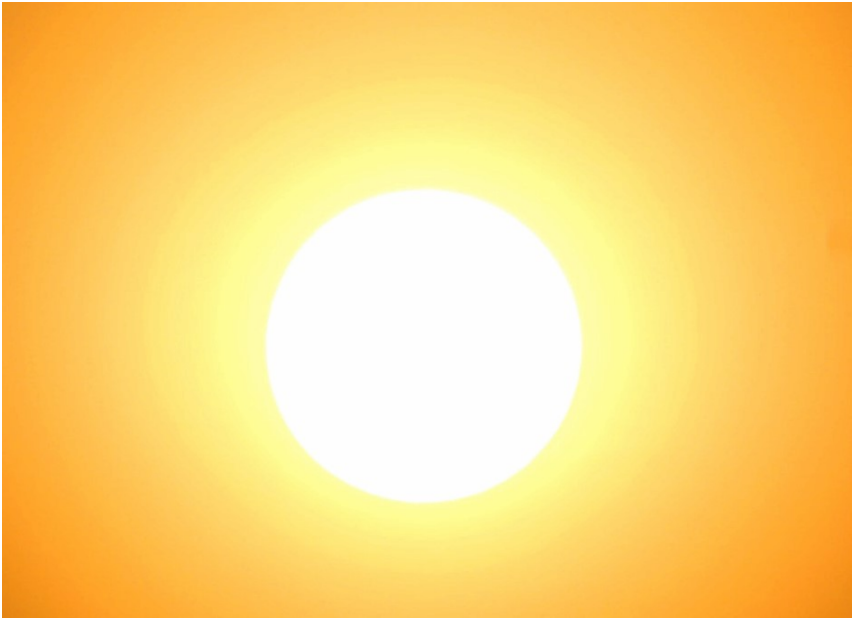

### HOLY MARTYRS OF ENGLAND AND WALES



John Payne returned to Elizabethan England as a missionary for the faith, basing himself in Ingatestone. He was betrayed, taken to the Tower, tortured, brought to Chelmsford Assizes and executed in 1582. His feast day is on 6<sup>th</sup> May.




### SS Philip and James : 3<sup>rd</sup> May

Philip was born in Bethsaida in Galilee and was one of the 12 Apostles that Jesus called. Immediately, Philip began to convert others, finding his friend Nathaniel and telling him that Jesus was the one whom Moses and the other prophets had foretold.

James the Lesser is called “Lesser” because he was younger than the other Apostle by the same name, James the Great. James the Lesser was related in some way to Jesus, and after Jesus’ Ascension into heaven, he became the head of the Church in Jerusalem.
