Governor News – June 2023

This is a monthly summary to help governors keep up to date with key themes of national education policy, the local Diocesan context, research and good practice.

DfE has published the <u>2023 version of the statutory guidance Keeping Children Safe in</u> <u>Education</u>. This **comes into force on 1 September 2023**

It is important that all governors are aware of their responsibilities for child protection and safeguarding - **especially new governors as part of their induction** and governors with a lead for monitoring safeguarding in your school. The next *Safeguarding Children* update will run as a webinar on **Monday 2 October 2023** (17:30-19:00) and cover all the essential information needed to understand your statutory responsibilities. DfE has updated their <u>statutory guidance on the suspension and permanent exclusion of</u> <u>pupils from maintained schools and academies</u> which **comes into force on 1 September 2023.** A summary of the changes can be found on pages 8 and 9

Review of RSHE - DfE has <u>announced the formation of an independent advisory panel who</u> <u>will provide expert advice on what is appropriate to be taught in RSHE and at what age</u> The review will be completed by the end of the year, following a consultation in the autumn

New Ofsted <u>research</u> commissioned by DfE highlights the impact of teachers' professional development on pupil outcomes following a survey and research-led visits by inspectors. Governing boards have an important role in establishing a culture where the continuing professional development (CPD) of leaders, teachers and other staff is valued and prioritised

England has risen to fourth out of 43 countries in the 2021 international reading literacy study (PIRLS) which assesses and compares the reading attainment and attitudes of pupils in their fourth year of formal schooling across participating countries

The latest surveys show a worrying rise in experimental vaping among 11 to 17-year-olds, with companies clearly marketing these products at children using colours, flavours and cheap disposable options. The government is taking steps to crack down on rogue firms targeting children with free samples and have announced a review into banning the vaping industry selling 'nicotine-free' vapes to under 18s
