Saint Thomas the Apostle – 3rd July

Thomas the Apostle, also known as *Didymus* (in Greek : “the twin”) was one of the twelve apostles of Jesus. He is often referred to as “Doubting Thomas” because he initially doubted the Resurrection when he was told about it, as related in the Gospel of John; he later confessed his faith (“My lord and my God”) on seeing the wounds of the crucifixion. It seems his mission reached India and his feast day is Indian Christians’ Day.
