## DO NOT BE AFRAID FOR YOUR GOD GOES WITH YOU

### PLACE OF PILGRIMAGE : HOLYWELL

is a site of pilgrimage in North Wales with the town taking its name from the 7<sup>th</sup>-century well of St Winefride, who was martyred for her beliefs. The well is one of the best examples of a medieval holy well in Britain.



### St Andrew Kim Taegon

was the first Korean born Catholic priest and is the patron saint of Korean clergy. He was baptised at the age 15 and joined the seminary in Macau, then became a priest and returned to Korea. Christianity was persecuted there, and at the age of 25 he was martyred near Seoul. He was canonised in 1984 during a visit of Pope John Paul II to Korea and he is celebrated on 20<sup>th</sup> September.
