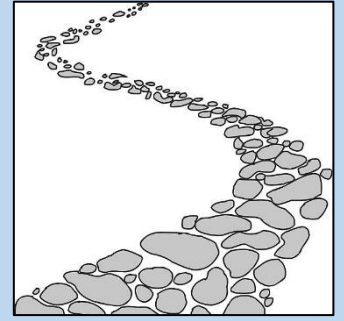





Pope Gregory I (540-604) was responsible for the first recorded large-scale mission from Rome, to convert the pagan Anglo-Saxons to Christianity. He wrote more than any previous pope and is famous for his *Dialogues*. He is the patron saint of teachers and musicians, as the song form Gregorian chant is named after him.
