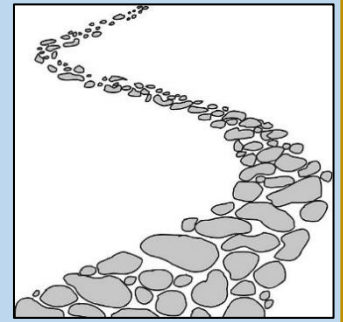
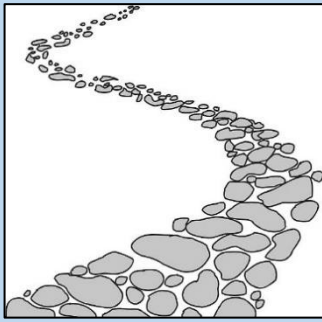

In Luke’s Gospel, we hear :

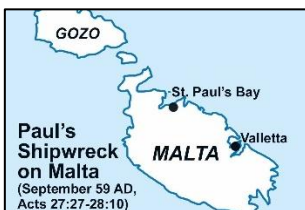

ST PAUL’S MISSIONARY JOURNEYS # 6 MALTA



On his way to Rome to face charges in 60 AD, Paul was shipwrecked on Malta. Traditionally, St Paul’s Bay is seen as the location for this disaster. The locals showed the victims of the shipwreck great kindness, building fires and giving food.



ST DAMASUS

Pope Damasus I was the bishop of Rome from October 366 to his death in 384. He presided over the Council of Rome of 382 that determined the canon or official list of sacred scripture. He spoke out against major heresies and solidified the faith of the Catholic Church, encouraged the production of the Latin Bible with his support for St Jerome. He helped reconcile the Church of Rome and the Church of Antioch, and encouraged the veneration of martyrs.
