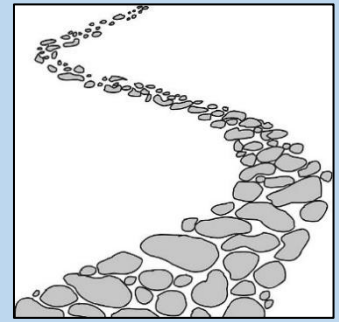


WALKING THE PATH
