


THE BULGARIAN CATHOLIC CHURCH

This Church uses the Byzantine liturgical rite in the Bulgarian language and in the Bulgarian Cyrillic alphabet. It has one diocese: the Bulgarian Greek Catholic Eparchy of Sofia.



The eparchy was set up as an Apostolic Exarchate in 1926 with the help of Archbishop Angelo Roncalli, the future Pope John XXIII.

ST FRANCIS OF PAOLA

St Francis (1416-1507) was a friar from the Calabrian town of Paola. As a boy, he lived for a year in a Franciscan convent and then, aged 15 but with his parents' permission, went to live as a hermit for six years. He was joined by others and founded the Order of Minims, "the least of the faithful"; he went on to found other religious communities. He later lived in France as adviser to the king. The picture shows a 'Nzuddha, a typical Calabrian honey cake, baked in the image of St Francis for his feast day.
